

CONSERVATION ASSESSMENT

The Efficiency Maine Trust Natural Gas Conservation Assessment charge included in MNG's rate schedules is provided below. The Conservation Assessment is charged on a Per Therm basis.

The Conservation Assessment charge by core rate schedule is shown below:

*Once MNG has collected the full amount remitted to the Commission for the period of October 9, 2014 through October 31, 2015, MNG will reduce the total charge for the EMT Natural Gas Conservation Assessment to \$0.0098 per therm of usage. MNG will submit a reconciliation filing to the Commission in the event of the MNG's discovery of an overcollection of the EMT Natural Gas Conservation Assessment.

Large Volume Customer Assessment

Pursuant to the July 23, 2015 Order on Trust's proposed addendum to amend its natural gas conservation program in Docket No. 2012-00449, large volume customers, defined as a consumer of a gas utility that uses 100,000 dekatherms or more of natural gas per year, shall not be assessed for EMT natural gas programs and such customers shall not be eligible to participate in EMT programs funded through those assessments.
